3 An Adjourned Meeting of the Council was held at the  
4 Municipal Hall on Monday, December 16th. 1918, at 5:30  
5 O'clock. p. m.

6 Present: - Councillors Richmond, Webb, Ward, Edgar, Helysuew  
7 and Murray.

8 The Clerk reported that his worship the Reeve had  
9 advised him that he would be unable to attend this  
10 meeting.

11 Moved by Cr. Murray, Seconded by Cr. Helysuew: - "That  
12 Councillor Webb do take the Chair as Acting Reeve for this  
13 meeting."

Carried unanimously.

15 Moved by Cr. Edgar, Seconded by Cr. Murray: - "That this  
16 Council do now resolve into a Committee of the Whole to  
17 reconsider the Burnaby Temporary Loan, No. 3, By Law 1918.  
18 with the Acting-Reeve in the Chair."

Carried unanimously.

20 Moved by Cr. Edgar, Seconded by Cr. Ward: - "That the  
21 Committee do now rise and report the By-Law complete  
22 without amendment."

Carried unanimously.

24 The Council re-convened.

25 Moved by Cr. Edgar, Seconded by Cr. Murray: - "That the Burnaby  
26 Temporary Loan, No. 3, By Law, 1918, be read a Third time."

Carried unanimously.

28 Moved by Cr. Edgar, Seconded by Cr. Ward: - "That the Burnaby  
29 Temporary Loan, No. 3, By Law, 1918, do pass the Third Reading,  
30 that it be signed by the Reeve and the Clerk, and the  
31 Corporate Seal be affixed thereto."

Carried unanimously.

33 The Hon. the Premier wrote advising that the B. C. V. Ry. Co.  
34 had made an application for permission to increase the  
35 Fares on the Central Park line.

36 The Clerk reported that the Reeve had ordered instructions  
37 to be given to the Corporation Solicitors to enter a protest,  
38 and to ask for a hearing.

39 Moved by Cr. Helysuew, Seconded by Cr. Edgar: - "That the letter  
40 be received and filed, and that the action of the Reeve  
41 herein, be confirmed."

Carried unanimously.

43 Mr. W. G. McQuasnie attended and explained the steps

1 which he had taken in this matter, and used that  
 2 a strong deputation appear at the hearing, which had  
 3 been arranged for Wednesday, December 18th: inst.  
 4 Moved by Cr. Edgar, Seconded by Cr. Mulpew: - That his  
 5 worship the Reeve be asked to attend with Mr. Me.  
 6 Quasie and if circumstances permit, the Clerk attend  
 7 also, at the hearing on the <sup>24th</sup> 1/5 inst. to oppose the  
 8 application of the B.C.C. Ry. Co.

Carried

11 The Secretary, Broadview Ratepayers' Association, wrote  
 12 endorsing the action of this Council in appealing the  
 13 recent decision of the Board of Railway Commissioners  
 14 re. increased fares on the Burnaby Lake line, B.C.C. Ry.  
 15 Moved by Cr. Murray, Seconded by Cr. Mulpew: - That  
 16 the letter be received and filed, and the contents  
 17 noted.

Carried unanimously.

19 Moved by Cr. Edgar, Seconded by Cr. Mulpew: - That this  
 20 Council do now adjourn.
