3 A Special Meeting of the Council was held at the
4 Municipal Hall on Tuesday, July 2nd, 1918, at 4 O'clock p.m.
5 in pursuance of Notice issued under the hand of his
6 Worship the Reeve, and duly served upon each member of
7 the Council.

8 The Reeve stated that the matter before the Council was
9 in relation to the payment of salaries of Teachers and Janitors
10 and other salaried officials in the employ of the Board of
11 School Trustees.

12 The Special Committee submitted a Report on their action
13 in pursuance with a Resolution passed on June 14th, ult.
14 and advised that the Reeve had considered it to be
15 necessary, in the best interests of the credit of this
16 Municipality, to issue an order to the Treasurer to pay
17 the Salaries in question.

18 Moved by Cr. Mulgrew, Seconded by Cr. Ward: - "That the
19 Report of the Special Committee, be adopted".

20 Carried unanimously.

21 Moved by Cr. Webb, Seconded by Cr. Edgar: - "That the
22 action of the Reeve, re. payment of salaries, be and is hereby
23 endorsed and confirmed".

24 Carried unanimously.

25 Moved by Cr. Webb, Seconded by Cr. Edgar: - "That this Council
26 do now adjourn".

27 Carried unanimously.
