

Monday- August 26th, 1918.

An Adjourned Meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall, on Monday, August 26th, 1918, at 8 p.m.

Present: Acting Reeve Webb,

Councillors Richmond, Ward, Edgaw, Mulgrew and Murray.

Moved by br. Edgaw, seconded by br. Mulgrew:-

"That the amended estimate of the Engineer, relating to the hard surfacing proposed for the Hastings-Barnet Road, as approved by the Board of Works, be adopted."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by br. Edgaw, seconded by br. Mulgrew:-

"That Tenders be called for laying an asphaltic concrete surface on a portion of the Hastings-Barnet Road; and also for the supply of 1700 cubic yards of crushed Rock, the Tenders to be in by noon, Tuesday, Sept. 3rd, 1918."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by br. Murray, seconded by br. Richmond:-

"That the deepest sympathy and condolence of this Council be extended to the relatives of the following Barnaby men, who have recently been killed in action, viz:-

Pte. E. V. Mc Cartney,

Lieut. Douglas Wright.

Pte. Frank Peterson."

Carried unanimously.
