

Monday - March 10th, 1919.

An Adjourned Meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall on Monday, March 10th, 1919 at 7.30 p.m.

Present: His Worship Rev. Sanderson,

Councillors Richmond, Hebb, Ward, Edgar, Lawson and Russell.

Moved by br. Lawson, seconded by br. Hebb: "That the Burnaby Temporary Loan No. 2 By-Law, 1919, be introduced and read a first time."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by br. Lawson, seconded by br. Hebb: "That the Burnaby Temporary Loan No. 2 By-Law, 1919, do pass the first reading."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by br. Lawson seconded by br. Hebb: "That the Burnaby Temporary Loan No. 2 By-Law, 1919, be read a second time."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by br. Lawson, seconded by br. Hebb: "That the Burnaby Temporary Loan No. 2 By-Law, 1919, do pass the second reading."

Carried unanimously.

The Ocean View Development, Ltd., wrote re. Patterson Avenue on the west side of the N.E. 1/4, D.L. 150, alleging that the roadway encroached upon their property.

Col. Dourell and Mr. Arnold, representing the company, attended and discussed the matter with the Council.

Moved by br. Hebb, seconded by br. Ward: "That the portion of Patterson Avenue lying between the N.E. 1/4 of D.L. 150 and the N.W. 1/4 of D.L. 149, extending from Imperial Street to Victory Road, be retained in its present location."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by br. Edgar, seconded by br. Hebb: "That a Surveyor be engaged forthwith to make the necessary survey of this portion of Patterson Avenue."

Carried unanimously.

R. Kerr Houlgate wrote, asking for approval of the cancellation of the sub-division plan of Lots 9, 10, and 11, Block 6, D.L. 74, Group One, Map No. 1852. The Engineer reported that it would be in order

1 to have this sub-division cancelled, as there would  
2 be no interference with any streets.

3 Moved by br. Russell, seconded by br. Keitt: "That  
4 the cancellation of the sub-division plan be  
5 approved."

7 Messrs. Mintemute & Robson filed an application  
8 for the cancellation of Block 11, D.L. 34, Group  
9 One, Map No. 2727.

10 The Engineer reported that it would be in order  
11 to cancel the sub-division plan, and that it is  
12 not necessary to retain the road allowance, as no  
13 useful purpose is served thereby.

14 Moved by br. Russell, seconded by br. Edgar: "That  
15 the cancellation of the sub-division plan be  
16 approved."

19 Lots 1 and 2, Block 40, D.L. 122/124, Group One,  
20 N.W.D. be sold to Mary Blouston, of Vancouver

22 Lot 1 - \$110.00. Lot 2 - \$100.00."
