

Monday-September 22nd, 1919.

An Adjourned Meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall, on Monday, September 22nd, 1919, at 7.35 p.m.

Present:- His Worship Reeve Sanderson, Councillors Richmond, Ward, Edgar, Lawson, and Russell.

Moved by br. Lawson, seconded by br. Edgar: "That the Animal Regulation By-Law, 1919, be introduced and read a first time."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by br. Lawson, seconded by br. Edgar: "That the Animal Regulation By-Law, 1919, do pass the First Reading."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by br. Lawson, seconded by br. Edgar: "That the Animal Regulation By-Law, 1919, be read a second time."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by br. Lawson seconded by br. Ward: "That the Animal Regulation By-Law, 1919, do pass the second reading."

Carried unanimously.

The Corporation Solicitors wrote re. Kingsway contract, forwarding Release signed by the Trustee for the California Liquid Asphalt Co. Ltd. direction of the Canadian Bank of Commerce, and the National Trust Company, to pay over the balance owing; together with letters from the Deputy Attorney-General of British Columbia and the Deputy Minister of Justice.

The Solicitors advised that these documents fairly protected this Municipality, and that their Corporation's cheque, of May 7th, is being paid over to Messrs. Taylor, Mayuz, Stockton & Smith."

Moved by br. Lawson, seconded by br. Ward: "That the letter be received, and the action taken be confirmed."
