

Monday, January 24th, 1919.

An Adjourned Meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall on Monday, January 24th, 1919, at 10 o'clock, a.m.

Present: - His Worship Reeve Sanderson.

Councillors Richmond, Webb, Ward, Edgar, Lawson, and Russell.

Correspondence was received and dealt with as follows:-

Solicitors - re. B.C.E.R. Taxes, Central Park line, enclosing copy of a letter from the Hon. the Premier to the General Manager, B.C.E.R., stating that he would fix a date for a further hearing, if the company desired to submit further evidence.

Moved by Mr. Webb, Seconded by Mr. Edgar: - "That the letters be received and filed, and the contents noted."

Carried unanimously.

City Clerk - North Vancouver re. Hospital Extension scheme.

C.M.C. - North Vancouver .. do.

C.M.C. - West Vancouver .. do.

Moved by Mr. Edgar, Seconded by Mr. Richmond: - "That the letters be received and filed, and the contents noted."

Carried unanimously.

Alex. Mackenzie and others - Complaint re. Burial of dead horses.

Secretary - Vancouver and Districts Joint Sewerage and Drainage Board, requesting that the Municipal Engineers be authorised to attend a meeting of Municipal Engineers to discuss the proposal that the Board take over the entire Sewerage System of Burrard Peninsula.

9 letter be received and filed, and that the Reeve appoint  
10 two delegates to attend the meeting."

11 Carried unanimously.

12 The Reeve nominated Councillors Edgar and Lawson, as  
13 delegates.

14 Secretary, Broadview Ratepayers' Association - approving the  
15 action of this Council in respect of the proposed Hospital  
16 Extension scheme

17 Moved by Br. Webb, Seconded by Br. Ward: - "That the letter be  
18 received and filed."

19 Carried unanimously.

20 Hon. the Provincial Secretary - re. Cemetery Site, D.L. 150,  
21 advising that unless his department be notified in a few  
22 days, of the disapproval of this Council, a certificate of  
23 approval would be issued to the applicant company.

24 The Reeve advised that he had on January 20th. inst. he  
25 instructed the Clerk to request the Provincial Secretary to  
26 defer any action herein, until after the letter should have  
27 been laid before the New Council on the 24th. inst.

28 Provincial Officer of Health - re Cemetery Site, D.L. 150,  
29 advising that a certificate of approval was issued to the  
30 applicant company on January 20th. inst.

31 P. W. West, M.L.A. enclosing copy of a letter to the Provincial  
32 Secretary, supporting the protest of Mr Chappell against the  
33 proposed cemetery, Ed. L. 150.

 3 Moved by Mr. Richmond, Seconded by Mr. Lawson: "That  
 4 this application be referred to the Corporation Solicitors  
 5 to report." Carried unanimously.
- 6 Solicitors re. Appeal B.C.G.R. rates and Board of  
 7 Railway Commissioners.  
 8 Moved by Mr. Edgar, Seconded by Mr. Russell: "That the  
 9 letter be received and filed." Carried unanimously.
- 10 11 the Minister of Lands. re. Appropriation for Housing  
 12 scheme. Carried unanimously.
- 13 Moved by Mr. Webb, Seconded by Mr. Edgar: "That this be  
 14 referred to the Finance Committee." Carried unanimously.
- 15 Mr. A. Somas attended and addressed the Council with  
 16 reference to the proposed Cemetery site D.L. 150.  
 17 The Reeve explained the action which had been taken  
 18 in the matter. Carried unanimously.
- 19 Harry Boag - Municipal Representative on the Dominion  
 20 Repatriation Committee - wrote suggesting the formation  
 21 of a "Welcome Home" Committee, with objects as outlined  
 22 in his letter. Carried unanimously.
- 23 Moved by Mr. Russell, Seconded by Mr. Edgar: "That the  
 24 letter be received and filed, and that a small  
 25 committee be appointed by the Reeve, to organize the  
 26 formation of a "Welcome Home" Committee, as suggested." Carried unanimously.
- 27 Councillors Webb, Edgar, and Russell were nominated by  
 28 the Reeve for this purpose. Carried unanimously.
- 29 Secretary, School Board - advising that Mr. Wm. Coulter  
 30 was appointed Chairman of the Board for 1919.  
 31 Moved by Mr. Edgar, Seconded by Mr. Russell: "That the letter  
 32 be received and filed." Carried unanimously.
- 33 Secretary - Burnaby Employees Association - Invitation to attend  
 34 the Annual Meeting on January 28th. inst. Carried unanimously.
- 35 Moved by Mr. Webb, Seconded by Mr. Lawson: "That the  
 36 invitation be accepted, and that as many attend as may  
 37 be possible." Carried unanimously.

1 The Clerk reported that the Assessment Roll of the Municipality  
 2 for 1919, was duly returned by the Assessor on January  
 3 5th. inst.

4 The Assessor submitted a summarised report of the 1919  
 5 Assessment.

6 Moved by Cr. Webb, Seconded by Cr. Edgar: - That the Assessment  
 7 Roll be received.

Carried unanimously.

8 Moved by Cr. Richmond, Seconded by Cr. Lawson: - That the  
 9 Report of the Assessor be received and filed.

Carried unanimously.

10 Moved by Cr. Webb, Seconded by Cr. Edgar: - That Councillors  
 11 Richmond, Edgar, Lawson and Russell, with the Reeve,  
 12 do constitute the Court of Revision of the 1919 Assessment Roll.

Carried unanimously.

13 Moved by Cr. Webb, Seconded by Cr. Edgar: - That the first  
 14 Sitting of the Court of Revision of the 1919 Assessment Roll,  
 15 be held on Monday, the 3rd. day of March, at 10 O'clock  
 16 in the forenoon, at the Council Chamber at the Municipal  
 17 Hall, Edmonds. B. C.

Carried unanimously.

18 Moved by Cr. Webb, Seconded by Cr. Richmond: - That Thomas  
 19 Sanderson, Reeve; G. L. Lawson, Chairman of Finance; and  
 20 Arthur G. Morse, Clerk; be and they are hereby authorised for  
 21 and in the name of the Corporation of the District of Burnaby  
 22 to draw, accept, sign, and make all or any Bills of Exchange,  
 23 Promissory Notes, Cheques, and Orders for the payment of money;  
 24 to pay and receive all moneys, and to give acquittance for  
 25 the same, to assign and transfer to the Bank all or any  
 26 Stocks, Bonds or other Securities; from time to time to borrow  
 27 money from the Royal Bank of Canada, either by overrawing  
 28 the account of the undersigned or otherwise, and generally,  
 29 for and in the name, and on behalf of the said Corporation,  
 30 to transact with the said Bank any business they may  
 31 think fit.

32 Also that Thomas Sanderson, Reeve; G. L. Lawson, Chairman  
 33 of Finance; and Arthur G. Morse, Clerk; or Richard Bolton,  
 34 Treasurer, or any of them, be and they are hereby  
 35 authorised on behalf of the said Corporation to negotiate  
 36 with, deposit with, or transfer to the said Bank (but for  
 37 credit of the said Corporation account only), all or any Bills  
 38 of Exchange, Promissory Notes, Cheques, or Orders for the  
 39 payment of money, and other negotiable paper, and for the

1 said propose to endorse the same or any of them on  
 2 behalf of the said Corporation; also from time to time to  
 3 arrange, settle, balance and certify all books and  
 4 accounts between the said Corporation and the Bank; and  
 5 to receive all paid cheques and vouchers, and to sign  
 6 the Bank's form of settlement of balances and release.

Carried unanimously.

8 Moved by Mr. Webb, Seconded by Mr. Edgar:- "That the Burnaby  
 9 Cemetery By Law, 1919, be introduced, and read a First  
 10 time".

Carried unanimously.

12 Moved by Mr. Webb, Seconded by Mr. Edgar:- "That the Burnaby  
 13 Cemetery By Law, 1919, do pass the First Reading".

Carried unanimously.

15 Moved by Mr. Webb, Seconded by Mr. Lawson:- "That the Burnaby  
 16 Cemetery By Law, 1919, be read a Second time".

Carried unanimously.

18 Moved by Mr. Webb, Seconded by Mr. Lawson:- "That the Burnaby  
 19 Cemetery By Law, 1919, do pass the Second Reading".

Carried unanimously.

21 Moved by Mr. Webb, Seconded by Mr. Lawson:- "That this  
 22 Council do meet on Monday, February 3rd, 1919, and on  
 23 every alternate Monday thereafter, at 4.30 o'clock p.m.,  
 24 and that the Committees meet on the intervening Mondays  
 25 at the same hour."

Carried unanimously.

27 Moved by Mr. Webb, Seconded by Mr. Ward:- "That this Council  
 28 do now adjourn until 10 o'clock a.m. on Wednesday,  
 29 January 19th. inst."
