An Adjudicated Meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall on Monday, November 3rd. 1919, at 8 O'clock p.m.

Moved by Cr. Russell, Seconded by Cr. Richmond: - That this Council do now resolve into a Committee of the Whole, with the Reeve in the Chair, to reconsider the Burnaby Septic Tank By Law. 1919.

Moved by Cr. Lawson, Seconded by Cr. Edgar: - That the "Short Title" be amended to read "Burnaby Sanitary By Law. 1919".

 29 signed by the Reeve and the Clerk, and that the Corporate
 30 Seal be affixed thereto."

 32 for Sale of Lots 1 and 2, Block 8, D.L. 116-17/186-S, to Bernard
 33 Mc. Glone be signed by the Reeve and the Clerk, and that
 34 the Corporate Seal be affixed thereto."

4 Co. fares.


5 Moved by Cr. Edgar, Seconded by Cr. Lawson: - "That the action
