An Adjourned Meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall on Monday, May 14th, 1920, at 4.45 p.m.

Councillors McLean, Coldicutt, Rummel, White, Lawson and Russell.

1. Moved by Mr. Lawson, Seconded by Mr. Coldicutt:—"That the Bernaldy Liquor License By Law, 1920, be introduced and read a First time."

Carried unanimously.

2. Moved by Mr. Lawson, Seconded by Mr. White:—"That the Bernaldy Liquor License By Law, 1920, do pass the First Reading."
