

Monday - July 26th. 1920.

An Adjourned Meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall on Monday, July 26th, 1920, at 4.30 p.m.

Present: - His Worship Reeve Sanderson.

Councillors McLean, Coldicutt, Rummel, White, Lawson, and Russell.

1. Moved by Mr. Lawson, Seconded by Mr. McLean: - "That the Summary General Borrowing and Hypothecation of Taxes By Law, No. 2, 1920, be introduced and read a First time."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Mr. Lawson, Seconded by Mr. McLean: - "That the Summary General Borrowing and Hypothecation of Taxes By Law, No. 2, 1920, do pass the First Reading."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Mr. Lawson, Seconded by Mr. McLean: - "That the Summary General Borrowing and Hypothecation of Taxes By Law, No. 2, 1920, be read a Second time."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Mr. Lawson, Seconded by Mr. McLean: - "That the Summary General Borrowing and Hypothecation of Taxes By Law, No. 2, 1920, do pass the Second Reading."

Carried unanimously.

2. Moved by Mr. Lawson, Seconded by Mr. McLean: - "That the Summary Sub-divisions By Law, 1920, lay over until the regular meeting."

Carried unanimously.

3. The Reeve read sundry telegrams to and from the Board of Railway Commissioners, with reference to the proposed increase of fares on the Central Park line of the B.C. Electric Railway.

Moved by Mr. McLean, Seconded by Mr. Russell: - "That it be left to the Reeve to call a meeting when necessary."

Carried unanimously.

4. A. M. Johnson applied for a temporary permit to operate the Royal Oak Hotel.

Moved by Mr. McLean, Seconded by Mr. Rummel: - "That the Clerk write to Mr. Johnson and explain the position of the Council herein."

Carried unanimously.

5. The Secretary, Civic Employe's Union wrote asking that the outside staff be allowed the half-day's wages, while

attending the proposed Civic Employe's picnic."

Moved by Cr. Coldicutt, Seconded by Cr. Rummel: - "That this lay over until Monday next."

Carried unanimously.

1. Moved by Cr. McLean, Seconded by Cr. White: - "That if the amount due on account of the purchase of Lots 1 to 4, A and Lots 51 to 54, Block 5, D.L. 94-10th, be not paid within 10 days from this date, that the Agreement for Sale in respect thereof, be cancelled."

Carried unanimously.

2. The Treasurer reported that the cheque given in respect of the purchase of Tax Sale Certificates of Lots 12, 13, & 14, Block 34, D.L. 189; and Lot 1 and W² of 2, Block 33, D.L. 53, had been dishonoured, and asked for authority to cancel the said certificates.

Moved by Cr. McLean, Seconded by Cr. White: - "That the certificates in question be cancelled."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr. McLean, Seconded by Cr. Lawson: - "That this Council do now adjourn."
