

Wednesday - July 28th. 1920

The Council met as a Committee of the Whole on Wednesday July 28th. 1920, at 10 o'clock. a.m., at the Municipal Hall.

Present:- His worship Reece Sanderson.

Councillors McLean, Lawson and Russell.

Mr. W. G. McQuarrie, of the Corporation Solicitors, was in attendance.

1. The matter of the proposed increase in B.C.S. Ry. fares on the Central Park line, was discussed.

Mr. McQuarrie explained the legal position. After a lengthy discussion, it was arranged that the Corporation Solicitors should telegraph to the Board of Railway Commissioners asking that the B.C.S. Ry. Co. be asked to furnish comparative statements of revenue and operating expenses covering the years 1914, 15, 16, 17, and 18; also asking that the Board's inspector be sent to investigate, and that the hearing be adjourned, and be held at Vancouver.

The Committee then adjourned.
