An Adjourned Meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall on Tuesday, April 6th, 1920, at 4.30 p.m.


1. The Returning Officer reported that at the Election for Councillor for Ward II, held on Wednesday, March 31st. ult., Thomas Davies Coldirett was duly elected by acclamation to fill the vacancy caused by the resignation of T. J. Keilly.
2. Councillors-elect Coldirett made and subscribed the Statutory oath of office before Justice G. Moore, J. P.
