

Monday - November 1st, 1921.

A Regular Meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall on Monday, November 1st, 1921, at 4.45 p.m.

Present:- His Worship Reeve Mr. Sean.

Councillors Young, Gairin, Rummel, Edgar, Mac Donald and Russell.

Moved by Mr. Edgar, Seconded by Mr. Mac Donald: - "That the Minutes of the Meeting of November 8th, be adopted as written, and confirmed."

Carried unanimously.

Correspondence was received and dealt with as follows:-

1. General Manager - Esitamia Mining and Smelting Co. - Thanks for Note of Condolence.

Moved by Mr. Rummel, Seconded by Mr. Mac Donald: - "That the letter be received and filed."

Carried unanimously.

2. Chief Constable - suggesting that a Christmas Hamper Fund be raised.

Moved by Mr. Edgar, Seconded by Mr. Rummel: - "That a Grant of \$25 be made to the Christmas Hamper Fund."

Carried unanimously.

3. Collector - re. W. S. of Bat 10, Blacky, T. D. L. I., recommending that a Conveyance of this property be made to Grace Elizabeth Mc Neill to correct an error made in connection therewith.

Moved by Mr. Edgar, Seconded by Mr. Young: - "That the recommendation be adopted."

2. Deputy Postmaster General re. Mail delivery service at Capitol Hill, advising that the conditions under which this service is supplied, have not yet been complied with. Moved by Cr. Edgar, Seconded by Cr. Russell: - "That the Engineer be instructed to prepare House numbering schedules for this district." Carried unanimously.
3. Moved by Cr. Mac Donald, Seconded by Cr. Young: - "That the Post Office department be asked to arrange for the establishment of a sub-post office to serve the district between Edmonds and Central Park." Carried unanimously.
4. C. Smith - Application on behalf of the Burnaby Lake Dramatic Club, for the use of the Public Hall for a performance and for rehearsals. Moved by Cr. Edgar, Seconded by Cr. Mac Donald: - "That the application be granted, on the usual terms." Carried unanimously.

Municipalities; and respectfully urges that the matter be given due consideration at the present session, in order that the relief so urgently needed by the Municipalities may be given, and become effective in 1922."

4. The Hon. the Provincial Secretary forwarded a copy of the order-in-council approving the Burnaby Waterworks Loan By Law, 1920, Repealing By Law, 1921. Moved by Mr. Russell, Seconded by Mr. Edgar: - "That the order be received and filed." Carried unanimously.
- Moved by Mr. Mac. Donald, Seconded by Mr. Russell: - "That this Council do now adjourn." Carried unanimously.
