

Monday - August 2nd. 1921.

The Council met as a Committee of the Whole at the Municipal Hall on Monday - August 2nd. 1921, at 9.15 p.m.

Present:- His worship Reeve Mr. Lean in the Chair.

Councillors Young, Gairin, Edgar, Rummel, MacDonald and Russell.

1. Moved by Mr. Mac Donald, Seconded by Mr. Edgar: - "That Councillor Rummel be appointed "Acting- Reeve" during the absence of the Reeve at the convention of the U.B.C.M." Carried unanimously.

2. Moved by Mr. Edgar, Seconded by Mr. Mac Donald: - "That the Public Works Department be asked to furnish a fresh coat of Tarvia on Hastings-Burnet Road, as against the \$500 expended by this Corporation during the current year." Carried unanimously.

3. Moved by Mr. Rummel, Seconded by Mr. Young: - "That this Council is in favour of a term longer than one year for Reeve and Councillors" Carried unanimously.

4. Moved by Mr. Gairin, Seconded by Mr. Young: - "That this Council is in favour of the control and administration of Schools, being taken back by the Province." Carried unanimously.

5. Moved by Mr. Russell, Seconded by Mr. Rummel: - "That this Council is in favour of the powers of the Inspector of Municipalities being enlarged to include the powers proposed to be given to a Local Government Board." Carried unanimously.

6. Moved by Mr. Rummel, Seconded by Mr. Edgar: - "That this Council recommends that provision be made by Statute for uniform "School" traffic signs throughout the Province." Carried unanimously.

- Moved by Mr. Rummel, Seconded by Mr. Edgar: - "That this Committee do now adjourn." Carried unanimously.
