

Monday - October 31st. 1921.

An Adjourned Meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall on Monday, October 31st. 1921, at 4.30 p.m.
Present: - His worship Reeve Mr. Lean.

Councillors Young, Guinn, Rummel, Edgar, MacDonald, and Russell.

1. Moved by Mr. Macdonald, Seconded by Mr. Edgar: - That this Council do now resolve into a Committee of the Whole, with the Reeve in the Chair, to reconsider the Burnaby Land Sale By Law, No. 23. 1921.

Carried unanimously.

- Moved by Mr. Macdonald, Seconded by Mr. Edgar: - That the Committee do now rise and report the By Law complete without amendment.

Carried unanimously.

The Council re-convened.

- Moved by Mr. Macdonald, Seconded by Mr. Edgar: - That the Burnaby Land Sale By Law, No. 23. 1921, be read a Third time.

- Moved by Mr. Edgar, Seconded by Mr. Macdonald: - That the Burnaby Waterworks Loan By Law, 1920, Repealing By Law, 1921, do pass the Third Reading; that it be signed by the Reeve and the Clerk, and that the Corporate Seal be affixed thereto.

Carried unanimously.

1. The Reeve submitted a Report re. Water supply to New Westminster advising that he had arranged that every available facility be given for assisting the City in its serious predicament caused by the washout of the City's water main.

Moved by Mr. Edgar, Seconded by Mr. Young: - "That the action of the Reeve herein, be endorsed."

CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

2. Moved from the Chair, Seconded by Mr. Rummel: - "That this Council express much profound regret, of the catastrophe at Britannia Beach on Friday, October 18th. inst., involving serious loss of life to the residents; and now desires to express its deepest sympathy with the sufferers in this calamity."
