

Monday - March 4th. 1921.

An Adjourned Meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall on Monday, March 4th. 1921, at 7.45 p.m.

Present: - His Worship, Reeve, McLean.

Councillors Young, Gavin, Rummel, Edgar, MacDonald, and Russell.

1. Moved by Mr. Rummel, Seconded by Mr. Gavin: - "That this Council do now resolve into a Committee of the Whole, with the Reeve in the Chair, to re-consider the Biennially Percentages Additions By Law, 1921."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Mr. MacDonald, Seconded by Mr. Rummel: - "That the Committee do now rise and report the By Law complete without amendment."

Carried unanimously.

The Council re-convened.

Moved by Mr. MacDonald, Seconded by Mr. Rummel: - "That the Biennially Percentages Additions By Law, 1921, be read a Third time."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Mr. MacDonald, Seconded by Mr. Young: - "That the Biennially Percentages Additions By Law, 1921, do pass the Third Reading; that it be signed by the Reeve and the Clerk, and that the Corporate Seal be affixed thereto."

Carried unanimously.

2. The Attorney General wrote, advising that there is no power to amend the Biennially School Loan By Law, in order to provide for the diversion of the funds set apart for a Domestic Science building at Edmonds Street School.

Moved by Mr. Rummel, Seconded by Mr. Gavin: - "That the letter be received and filed for reference, and that a copy thereof be sent to the Secretary of the School Board."

Carried unanimously.

3. The Solicitors wrote re. Assessment Appeals, advising the assessments have been reduced by Mr Justice Macdonald as follows:-
