

Monday, June 12th. 1922.

An Adjourned Meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall on Monday, June 12th. 1922 at 11.30p.m.

Present: - His worship Reeve W. Lean.

Councillors Young, Gairn, Rummel, Edgar, Lawson, and Russell.

1. Moved by Mr. Edgar, Seconded by Mr. Rummel: - "That this Council do now resolve into a Committee of the Whole, with the Reeve in the Chair, to re-consider the Bernaldy Temporary Debiture By Law, 1922."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Mr. Edgar, Seconded by Mr. Gairn: - "That the Committee do now rise and report the By Law complete, without amendment."

Carried unanimously.

The Council re-convened.

Moved by Mr. Edgar, Seconded by Mr. Rummel: - "That the Bernaldy Temporary Debiture By Law, 1922, be read a Third time."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Mr. Rummel, Seconded by Mr. Lawson: - "That the Bernaldy Temporary Debiture By Law, 1922, do pass the Third Reading; that it be signed by the Reeve and the Clerk, and that the Corporate Seal be affixed thereto."

Carried unanimously.

2. Moved by Mr. Russell, Seconded by Mr. Lawson: - "That the Agreement between this Corporation and the D. C. Electric Railway Company Limited for lighting the streets of this Municipality, be signed by the Reeve and the Clerk, and that the Corporate Seal be affixed thereto."

Carried unanimously.

3. Moved by Mr. Young, Seconded by Mr. Rummel: - "That the Agreement between this Corporation and the Canadian Telephones, Limited, re Extra ordinary Traffic on Barnett Road, be signed by the Reeve and the Clerk; and that the Corporate Seal be affixed thereto."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Mr. Rummel, Seconded by Mr. Gairn: - "That this Council do now adjourn."
