

Monday, February 20th, 1922.

An Adjourned Meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall on Monday, February 20th, 1922, at 7.45 p.m.

Present: His worship Reeve Mr. Lean.

Councillors Young, Garin, Edgar, Mac Donald, and Russell.

1. Moved by Mr. Garin, Seconded by Mr. Young: - "That this Council do now resolve into a Committee of the Whole, with the Reeve in the Chair, to re-consider the Edmonds Development Company Mortgage Property Sale By Law, 1922."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Mr. Garin, Seconded by Mr. Edgar: - "That the Committee do now rise and report the By Law complete, without amendment."

Carried unanimously

The Council re-convened.

Moved by Mr. Garin, Seconded by Mr. Young: - "That the Edmonds Development Company Limited Mortgage Property Sale By Law 1922, be read a Third time."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Mr. Garin, Seconded by Mr. Young: - "That the Edmonds Development Company Limited Mortgage Property Sale By Law, 1922, do pass the Third Reading; that it be signed by the Reeve and the Clerk, and that the Corporate Seal be affixed thereto."

3. The Board of Police Commissioners submitted Estimates for

the current year, amounting to \$12,920.00

Moved by Mr. Russell, Seconded by Mr. Edgar: - "That the Estimate submitted by the Board of Police Commissioners be approved, save and except the proposed increases of salaries to the members of the Police Force, and that an appeal be taken to the Lieutenant-Governor-in-Council against the said proposed increases of salaries.

Carried unanimously.

1. The Vancouver and Districts Joint Sewerage and Drainage Board submitted a statement of the Assessment Levy, for the year 1922, amounting to \$14282.96.

Moved by Mr. Edgar, Seconded by Mr. Russell: - "That this lay on the Table for further consideration."

Carried unanimously.

2. The Board of School Trustees submitted a revised Estimate of Extra-ordinary Expenditure, amounting to \$9150.96.

Moved by Mr. Edgar, Seconded by Mr. Lawson: - "That the Board of School Trustees be and is hereby permitted to withdraw the Estimate of Extra-ordinary Expenditure, presented on the 15th. day of February, inst."

Carried unanimously.

3. Moved by Mr. Edgar, Seconded by Mr. Russell: - "That the Resolution passed by this Council on the 15th. day of February inst. with reference to the Estimates submitted by the School Board, be amended by striking out the following words in the said resolution, viz: - "and the sum of \$5000 and no more, for Extra-ordinary Expenditure."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Mr. Edgar, Seconded by Mr. Lawson: - "That item (a) New School Sites \$469.55, be approved."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Mr. Edgar, Seconded by Mr. Young: - "That item (b) New School Buildings, \$1500, be disapproved."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Mr. Edgar, Seconded by Mr. Garin: - "That item (c) Furniture and Equipment for new School Buildings - \$4422.50, be approved."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Mr. Edgar, Seconded by Mr. Young: - "That item (d) Alterations and Additions to old School Buildings - \$1400, be disapproved."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Mr. Edgar, Seconded by Mr. Garin: - "That item (e) Other Special or Extra ordinary Expenditure - \$2644.50, be approved."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Mr. Edgar, Seconded by Mr. Garin: - "That the sum of \$5950.96, and no more, for the Extra ordinary Expenditure

of the Board of School Trustees, be placed in the Estimates for the year 1922.

Carried unanimously.

1. The Assessor submitted a statement of the Assessment as revised and confirmed by the Court of Revision.
Moved by Mr. Edgar, Seconded by Mr. Gaim: "That this be received and filed."

Carried unanimously.

2. A Deputation from the Unemployed, attended and addressed the Council, with reference to various matters.
The Reeve replied in answer to the points raised by the deputation.

Moved by Mr. Lawson, Seconded by Mr. Gaim: "That this Council do now adjourn."

Carried unanimously.
