

Monday - May 21st. 1923.

An Adjourned Meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall on Monday, May 21st. 1923, at 7-30 p.m.

Present:- His worship Reeve Mc. Leam.

Councillors Young, Gairn, Rummel, Edgar, Lawson, Ladner, and Taylor.

1. Moved by Mr. Rummel, Seconded by Mr. Ladner:- "That this Council do now resolve into a Committee of the Whole, with the Reeve in the Chair, to reconsider the Burnaby Land Sale By Law, No. 4. 1923.

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Mr. Rummel, Seconded by Mr. Lawson:- "That the Committee do now rise and report the By Law complete, without amendment.

Carried unanimously.

The Council re-convened.

Moved by Mr. Rummel, Seconded by Mr. Ladner:- "That the Burnaby Land Sale By Law, No. 4, 1923, be read a Third time.

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Mr. Rummel, Seconded by Mr. Young:- "That the Burnaby Land Sale By Law, No. 4. 1923, do pass the Third Reading; that it be signed by the Reeve and the Clerk, and that the Corporate Seal be affixed thereto."

Carried unanimously.

2. Moved by Mr. Young, Seconded by Mr. Ladner:- "That the Agreement with Harvey. C. Raymer re. Crossing, be signed by the Reeve and the Clerk, and that the Corporate Seal be affixed thereto, provided that a favourable recommendation hereon from the Municipal Engineer is furnished to the Reeve and the Clerk."

Carried unanimously.

3. The Reeve submitted a recommendation that this Corporation take no further part in the meetings with reference to the proposed Greater Vancouver Water Commission; and oppose any attempt to carry the proposed Bill through the Provincial House.

Moved by Mr. Lawson, Seconded by Mr. Rummel:- "That this recommendation be adopted."

Carried unanimously.

The Board of School Trustees attended and addressed the Council upon the following matters:-

4. 1. Access to North Burnaby High School site

Moved by Mr. Lawson, Seconded by Mr. Rummel:- "That this

be referred to Mr. Lawson and the Engineer, with power to act.  
Carried unanimously.

1. A request to amend the Bermuda School Loan By Law, 1922, by striking out the item - "Four rooms - Howard Avenue, \$20,000"; and substituting therefor the item - "Four rooms D. L. 205 - \$20,000."

Moved by Mr. Edgar, Seconded by Mr. Rummel: - "That the request of the Board be complied with, subject to Title to the site being obtained."

Carried unanimously.

2. Moved by Mr. Edgar, Seconded by Mr. Rummel: - "That application on behalf of this Corporation be made to the Government for a Crown Grant of the 10 acres comprised in Lot 25, Block 1. D. L. 205. Group One - for school purposes."

Carried unanimously.

3. A. Grimwood attended with reference to the complaint of himself and others, of an alleged nuisance arising from the Alberni Poultry Yards, at Kingway and Chappoy Ave.  
Moved by Mr. Ladner, Seconded by Mr. Rummel: - "That the Medical Health Officer be requested to take steps to have the nuisance abated forthwith."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Mr. Edgar, Seconded by Mr. Rummel: - "That this Council do now adjourn."
