

Monday, December 5th, 1925

An Adjourned Meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall on Monday, December 5th, 1925, at 7.30 p.m.

Present: - His Worship Reece W. Lean.

1. Moved by Mr. Young, Seconded by Mr. Longley: - "That Councillors Garin and Ladner, with the Reece, do constitute the Court of Revision of the 1924 Voters' Lists."
Carried unanimously.
2. The Secretary, Ward & Ratepayers' Association wrote, suggesting a complete re-assessment of this Municipality. Moved by Mr. Rummel, Seconded by Mr. Longley: - "That this be referred to the 1924 Council."
Carried unanimously.
3. The Secretary, Ward & Ratepayers' Association wrote, expressing the appreciation by his Association of the work accomplished by this Council during the past year. Moved by Mr. Rummel, Seconded by Mr. Edgar: - "That the letter be received and filed."
Carried unanimously.
4. C. Goodale wrote, supporting the stand taken by this Council in opposing any change in the name "Kingsway" and congratulating this Council upon its administration. Moved by Mr. Edgar, Seconded by Mr. Longley: - "That the letter be received and filed."
Carried unanimously.
5. Councillor Longley gave Notice of Motion to introduce a Roads By-Law for \$30000.

Moved by Mr. Rummel, Seconded by Mr. Garin: - "That this Council do now adjourn."
