A Regular Meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall on Monday, July 9th, 1923, at 4-30 p.m.

Present: - His worship Reece Mr. Dean.

Councillors Young, Gauvin, Rummel, Edgar, Lawson, Ladner, and Engberg.

Moved by Cr. Lawson, Seconded by Cr. Engberg: - "That the Minutes of the Meeting of June 26th, ult. be adopted as written, and confirmed."

Carried unanimously.

Correspondence was received and dealt with, as follows:-

1. Superintendent of Lands - advising that a Crown Grant was issued on June 13th, 1923, in respect of Lot 15, Block 1, D. L. 105.

## Water Committee Report:-

Your Committee met on July 3rd. 1923, and recommend:-

1. That the present arrangement for sprinkling hours, be suspended, and that sprinkling be permitted for any period not exceeding four hours in each day.
2. That the Estimate of Work for the two weeks commencing July 3rd. amounting to \$332.40, be adopted.
3. That the Supplementary Estimate, \$105.94, be adopted.
4. That the Estimate for Construction, \$94.60, be adopted, provided funds are available.
5. That extensions be laid as follows:-

3. That Mr. Kelly be paid at the rate of \$10 per. 8 hour day, for

4. That Mr. C. Stewart be allowed 50 cents per day, for gasoline and oil, in respect of the use of his motor car in connection with construction of permanent sidewalks.
5. That tenders for work on Smith Avenue be referred to Mr. Englehardt, with the Engineer and the Clerk.
6. That the plan of .41 ac. of the 5 ac. part of D.L. 1, be finally approved.
7. That an Appropriation not exceeding \$400 from the Contingent Fund, be made for the work of drainage and widening on Hastings Street in the 5900 and 4000 Blocks.
8. That Mr. Dawson be authorised to have the sign at Boundary Road re-painted, at a cost not exceeding \$10.
