

Monday - December 1st. 1924.

An adjourned meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall on Monday, December 1st. 1924, at 4. 30 p.m.
Present:- His Worship Reeve W.C. Dean.

Councillors Neville, Gamm, Rummel, Edgar, Campbell, Murray, and Langford.

Moved by Mr. Edgar, Seconded by Mr. Rummel:- "That this Council do now resolve into a Committee of the Whole, with the Reeve in the Chair, to re-consider the Burmaby Land Sale By Law, No. 8. 1924."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Mr. Edgar, Seconded by Mr. Rummel:- "That the Committee do now rise and report the By Law complete, without amendment."

Carried unanimously.

The Council re-convened.

Moved by Mr. Edgar, Seconded by Mr. Rummel:- "That the Burmaby Land Sale By Law, No. 8. 1924, be read a Third time."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Mr. Edgar, Seconded by Mr. Rummel:- "That the Burmaby Land Sale By Law, No. 8. 1924, do pass the Third Reading, that it be signed by the Reeve and the Clerk, and that the Corporate Seal be affixed thereto."

Carried unanimously.

2 The Secretary, School Board wrote asking that a date be set upon which to receive a Supplementary Estimate of Extra-ordinary Expenditure.

Moved by Mr. Rummel, Seconded by Mr. Gamm:- "That the first day of December 1924, be set as the date upon which to receive the said Supplementary Estimate."

Carried unanimously.

The Secretary, School Board, wrote, submitting a Supplementary Estimate of Extra-ordinary Expenditure, amounting to \$89.448.00 less a possible grant from the Government.

Moved by Mr. Rummel, Seconded by Mr. Edgar:- "That this Supplementary Estimate be and is hereby rejected."

Carried unanimously.

3 Mr. F. A. Browne, M.L.A. telephoned a message, asking if this Council approved an amendment to the Act to regulate Horse Racing, submitted by Mr. Woods of the Glenlyon Country Club.

Moved by Mr. Murray, Seconded by Mr. Rummel:- "That this Council does not wish to discuss the question as to how many days racing shall be permitted, but desires protection for the agreement with the Glenlyon Country Club."

Carried unanimously.

The Special Committee reported verbally that the W. View Shingle Co. be charged a nominal rental of \$5. per year for the mill buildings on D.L. 100.

Moved by Br. Rummel, Seconded by Br. Edgar: - That the W. View Shingle Co. be charged a rental of \$5.00 per month.

Lovised unanimously.

Moved by Br. Edgar, Seconded by Br. Campbell: - That this Council do now adjourn.
