

Monday, July 1st, 1924.

A Regular Meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall on Monday, July 1st, 1924, at 4-30 p.m.

Present:- His Worship Reeve Mr. Dean.

Councillors McVille, Guinn, Rummel, Edgar, Campbell and
Councillor Englehardt.

At the Minutes of the meeting of July 7th, inst., it was adopted as ^{written and confirmed} ~~read and confirmed~~ that the minutes be accepted.

Correspondence was received and dealt with, as follows:-

(1) Mr. Parsons, Brown and Winckles, Ltd. re. Claim of Gilbert Marshall, advised that the applicant has no claim on this corporation.

Moved by Mr. Edgar, Seconded by Mr. Campbell:- "That this letter be received and filed."

Carried unanimously.

(2) Parsons, Brown and Winckles, Ltd. re. Claim of Miss J. Reid. advising that this corporation is not liable in this case.

Moved by Mr. Edgar, Seconded by Mr. Englehardt:- "That this letter be received and filed."

Carried unanimously.

(3) City Clerk, Vancouver, asking if this corporation is prepared to join in the formation of a Greater Vancouver Metropolitan Area.

Moved by Mr. Rummel, Seconded by Mr. McVille:- "That the City Council be advised that this corporation is in favour of a Greater Vancouver Metropolitan Area, along certain lines."

(4) Moved by Mr. Guinn, Seconded by Mr. Campbell:- "That the Insurance Co. be asked to re-consider the Gilbert Marshall claim."

(5) The Salvation Army wrote, extending thanks for Grant. Moved by Mr. Edgar, Seconded by Mr. Englehardt:- "That the letter be received and filed."

(6) Mr. A. L. Harrison - protesting against the increased water rates.

1. Secretary - Associated Property Owners of Vancouver, asking for data concerning the cost of the Waterworks System, the revenue derived therefrom, and the provision made for liquidating the debt at maturity.

Moved by C. Edgar, Seconded by C. McVille: - That the writer be referred to the report of the Inspector of Municipalities.

Closed unanimously.
