

Tuesday - April 22nd. 1924.

An Adjourned Meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall on Tuesday - April 22nd. 1924, at 7-30 p.m.

Present :- His worship Reeve McLean.

Councillors Meville, Gavin, Rummel, Edgar, Campbell, Murray, and Langley.

1. Moved by Cr. Rummel, Seconded by Cr. Gavin: - "That this Council do now resolve into a Committee of the Whole, with the Reeve in the Chair, to reconsider the Burnaby Waterworks Regulation By Law, 1912, Amendment By Law, 1924."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr. Rummel, Seconded by Cr. Meville: - "That the Committee do now rise and report the By Law complete, without amendment."

Carried unanimously.

The Council re-convened.

Moved by Cr. Edgar, Seconded by Cr. Rummel: - "That the Burnaby Waterworks Regulation By Law, 1912, Amendment By Law, 1924, be read a Third time."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr. Edgar, Seconded by Cr. Murray: - "That the Burnaby Waterworks Regulation By Law, 1912, Amendment By Law, 1924, do pass the Third Reading; that it be signed by the Reeve and the Clerk; and that the Corporate Seal be affixed thereto."

Moved by Cr. Rummel, Seconded by Cr. Meville: - "That the Burnaby Temporary Debenture By Law, 1922, Repealing By Law, 1924 do pass the First Reading."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr. Rummel, Seconded by Cr. Murray: - "That the Burnaby Temporary Debenture By Law, 1922, Repealing By Law, 1924 be read a Second time."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr. Rummel, Seconded by Cr. Meville: - "That the Burnaby Temporary Debenture By Law, 1922, Repealing By Law, 1924, do pass the Second Reading."

3. The Reeve submitted correspondence relating to the case of John. W. Scott, a returned soldier's applicant for a position as

a Customs guard at Vancouver.

Moved by Cr. Edgar, Seconded by Cr. Murray: - "That this be left to the Reeve to take up with the authorities."

Moved by Cr. Rummel, Seconded by Cr. Edgar: - "That this Council do now adjourn."
