- Moved by Mr. Rummel, Seconded by Mr. Gairin: - "That this Council do now resolve into a Committee of the Whole, with the Reeve in the Chair, to reconsider the Burnaby Waterworks Regulation By Law, 1912, Amendment By Law, 1924."
