

Monday - February 25th. 1924

An Adjourned Meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall on Monday, February 25th. 1924, at 7.30 p.m.

Present: - His worship Reece M. Lean.

Councillors Keeble, Gairn, Rummel, Edgar, Campbell, Murray, and Coupland.

1. The Estimates of the Board of School Trustees were considered. The Treasurer and the Auditor reported that the items of the Ordinary Estimates were in order.

Moved by Cr. Edgar, Seconded by Cr. Coupland: - "That the Report be received and filed."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr. Edgar, Seconded by Cr. Murray: - "That the ordinary Estimates, \$149,600.59, be approved."

Carried unanimously.

The Chairman of the Board of School Trustees attended, and explained various items in the Extra-ordinary Estimates.

Moved by Cr. Murray, Seconded by Cr. Coupland: - "That the Extra-ordinary Estimates \$13,415.25, be approved."

Carried unanimously.

2. The Board of Police Commissioners submitted Estimates for the current year, amounting to \$24,311.00.

Moved by Cr. Edgar, Seconded by Cr. Rummel: - "That the Police Estimates be approved."

Carried unanimously.

3. Moved by Cr. Edgar, Seconded by Cr. Murray: - "That a letter of appreciation be sent to the B. C. Ry. Co. regarding the proposed reduction of domestic lighting rates."

Carried unanimously.

4. The Reece asked the Special Committee for a Report in reference to the B. C. Telephone Co. and "Glenview" Exchange. Cr. Edgar reported verbally.

Moved by Cr. Rummel, Seconded by Cr. Edgar: - "That this Council do now adjourn."
