

Monday. February 4th. 1924.

A Regular Meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall on Monday, February 4th. 1924, at 7-30 p.m.

Present:- His worship Reeve Mr. Lean.

Councillors Marille, Gairin, Edgar, Campbell, Murray, and Engleby.

Mr. Burnell was absent on account of illness.

Moved by Mr. Edgar. Seconded by Mr. Engleby:- "That the Minutes of the Meeting of January 14th, ulto, be adopted as written and confirmed." Carried unanimously.

Correspondence was received and dealt with, as follows:-

1. Secretary - South west Burnaby Ratepayers' Association acknowledging receipt of copy of light analysis.

Moved by Mr. Engleby. Seconded by Mr. Edgar:- "That the letter be received and filed." Carried unanimously.

2. Secretary, South west Burnaby Ratepayers' Association forwarding copy of a resolution re. Sign at Central Park, B. C. B. Ry.

Moved by Mr. Murray. Seconded by Mr. Neville:- "That the B. C. B. Ry. be asked to advise whether there is any contract existing in respect of the sign in question, and if so, for what term, and also if the company would be willing to agree to the removal of the sign to another location." Carried unanimously.

3. The Chairman - Vancouver Publicity Committee, asking for a grant for publicity purposes.

Moved by Mr. Edgar, Seconded by Mr. Campbell: "That the Corporation Solicitors be instructed to institute foreclosure proceedings in this case."

2. The Reeve submitted a recommendation that the Cleveland motor cycle used by the Electrician be traded in for a new machine at \$315. less \$155. for the old machine. Moved by Mr. Edgar, Seconded by Mr. Murray: "That the recommendation of the Reeve be adopted."
