

Monday - December 8th. 1924.

A Regular Meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall on Monday, December 8th. 1924, at 7-30 p.m.

Present:- His Worship Reeve Mr. Dean.

Councillors Neville, Gammie, Rummel, Edgar, Murray, and Engberg.  
Moved by Mr. Rummel, Seconded by Mr. Edgar:- That the Minutes of the meetings of November 14th. ult., and December 1st. inst. be adopted as written, and confirmed.

CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

Correspondence was received and dealt with, as follows:-

1. Secretary, V.O.W. asking if a Grant could be made to the Province Santa Claus Fund.

Moved by Mr. Rummel, Seconded by Mr. Engberg:- That a Grant of \$25<sup>00</sup> be made to the Province Santa Claus Fund.

CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

2. Upper Bell and Upper re. Sewers. D.L. 186, disclaiming on behalf of the owners, any liability to repair the broken sewers.  
Moved by Mr. Rummel, Seconded by Mr. Neville:- That this day over pending a report from the Medical Health Officer.

CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

3. Secretary, U.B.C.M. forwarding copy of a pamphlet relating to School Taxation, which was presented by the Executive of the Union to the Provincial Government.

Moved by Mr. Rummel, Seconded by Mr. Edgar:- That the pamphlet be received and be available for inspection by the members of this Council, who may report thereon, should they so desire.

CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

4. The Engineer re. Street Light, Madison Avenue, Ward 5, asking that the B.C.R.R. be advised that this corporation will pay the cost, \$25<sup>00</sup> for the extra distance involved by the location of this light.

Moved by Mr. Edgar, Seconded by Mr. Murray:- That this item pass provided Ward 5 funds are available therefor.

CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

5. Chief Constable - reporting the attendance of the New Westminster Fire Department at two recent fires in Burnaby during the month of November.

Moved by Mr. Edgar, Seconded by Mr. Neville:- That a Grant of \$25<sup>00</sup> be made to the Benevolent Fund of the New Westminster Fire Department for services in attending at each of these fires.

CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

H. Burns and others - Petition asking that a Referendum be submitted to the electors of Ward 5 at the Municipal Elections, on

the question of whether Wood should be declared a District Improvement Area.

Moved by Dr. Rummel, Seconded by Dr. Edgar: "That the petition he received and filed, and that the applicants be informed that this Council cannot see its way clear to accede to this request." Carried unanimously.

Committee Reports:-

1. Finance Committee Report: - Your Committee met on December 1st. 1924, and recommend:-

1. That General Accounts, amounting to \$ 5515.50, be paid.
2. That Wages, amounting to \$ 2195.49, be paid.
3. That Salaries, amounting to \$ 41.52, be paid.
4. That the account of the Children Aid Society for maintenance of three children of John Siderup, amounting to \$ 90.56, be paid.
5. That Lt. Edwards be paid an instalment on account of work done on Spending Avenue Bridge.
6. That payment of \$ 400.00 be made to Murray and Raugh from the amount retained in respect of Spending Avenue contract.
7. That the tender of the Bohemian Co. for binding Assessment Roll \$ 62.50, be accepted.
8. That the Requisition be confirmed.
9. That \$ 500.00 be taken from the Contingent Fund and be appropriated to the several Wards for Board of Works purposes in the same proportion as the original appropriation.
10. That the Appropriation of \$ 150.00 for a grant to the R.A.F. Society be directed to Boundary Road Sidewalk.
11. That Mr. James Smith be notified that his services will not be required after December 1st. 1924, owing to new arrangements having been made with the Vancouver General Hospital.

  2. That the Supplementary Estimate, \$ 150.00, be approved.

4 Board of Works Report: -

Your Committee met on December 1st. 1924, and recommends:-

1. That an Easement be obtained from Miss Campbell's property, Block 15, D.L. 157/5.
  2. That the Sub. division plan of Lot A, Block 8, D.L. 125, be tentatively approved.
  3. That F. Willison be granted permission to plant Mountain Ash trees on the boulevards of Beaton Street and Stride Avenue.
  4. That the 0.49 acre portion of H. Mikala's property in D.L. 215 be purchased for road purposes at a cost of \$500.00.
  5. That the Columbia Estate Co. be asked to dedicate a \$8' road allowance on the West side of D.L. 56.
  6. That the request of Ward 5 Ratepayers' Association for a Pump Sewer on Queens Avenue be referred to the Vancouver and Districts Joint Sewerage and Drainage Board.
  7. That sundry applications be referred to the Engineers and the Councillors for the several Wards.

3. The Medical Health Officer submitted a Report with reference to sanitary conditions in Ward 5, North Burnaby.
- Moved by Mr. McVille, Seconded by Mr. Edgar. - That the instructions given by the Reeve to the Engineers re. broken sewer S. L. 186 be confirmed.

CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

- Moved by Mr. Engleay, Seconded by Mr. Murray. - That the recommendations of the Medical Health Officer re. Septic Tanks, be adopted and referred to the Solicitor and Engineers.

CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

4. The Special Committee submitted a statement of Debentures purchased during the current year, of a total face value of \$51,459.46, at a total cost of \$46,544.92.

- Moved by Mr. Rummel, Seconded by Mr. Edgar. - That the Statement be received and filed, and that the Reeve, with Mr. Rummel, the Treasurer, the Auditors, and the Clerk, be a Committee to cancel and destroy the Debentures so purchased.

CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

- Moved by Mr. Edgar, Seconded by Mr. Gamm. - That in view of the possibility of the elimination of the second paragraph of Section 90 of the Greater Vancouver Water District Act, and to substitute therefor a provision that upon the coming into effect of the said Act, all agreements respecting the supply of water, existing between any Municipalities within the district, be abrogated;

the City Council of Vancouver be notified that this Corporation will require the City to fulfil the obligations assumed under the Agreement between the City and this Corporation respecting a supply of water from Seymour Creek.

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Mr. Remond, Seconded by Mr. Neville: - "That a telegram be sent to the Chairman of the Special Committee re. Greater Vancouver Water District Act, as follows:-

"I am directed to forward for the consideration of your Committee, the following copy of a resolution passed by this Council:-

(Here follows copy of the foregoing resolution)

"This Corporation also takes strong exception to any change of Section 49 and 105 unless the rights and interests of Burnaby under the agreement with the City are amply and adequately protected.

"This Corporation also takes strong exception to the proposed new Section 92-A, and begs to submit that the principle of permitting any private person or corporation to interfere, through the Government, with the capital expenditures of the Board, is extremely vicious, as these monies will be raised solely upon the credit of the taxpayers of the Municipalities within the area.

"This Corporation also takes exception to any changes being made in sub-section 4 of section 10, or of section 42, or of the section dealing with distribution."
