

Monday July 27th. 1925.

An adjourned meeting of the Council was held in the Municipal Hall on Monday July 27th. 1925 at 7.30 p.m.

Present: His Worship Reeve McLean:

Councillors: Smith, Hall, Rummel, Reid, Gibbs, Murray and Engberg:

Moved by Cr. Rummel, Seconded by Cr. Reid: "That this Council do now resolve into a committee of the whole with the Reeve in the Chair to reconsider the J.G. & B.E. West Property By-law 1925."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr. Rummel, Seconded by Cr. Hall: "That the Committee do now rise and report the By-law complete without amendment."

Carried unanimously.

The Council Reconvened.

Moved by Cr. Rummel, Seconded by Cr. Gibbs: "That the J.G. & B.E. West Property By-law 1925 be read a Third time."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr. Rummel, Seconded by Cr. Gibbs: "That the J.G. & B.E. West Property By-law 1925 do pass the Third reading, that it be signed by the Reeve and the Clerk, and that the Corporate seal be affixed thereto."

Moved by Cr. Reid, Seconded by Cr. Hall: "That the action of the Reeve be confirmed."

The Corporation of Point Gray forwarded copy of Water Notice - Application to take and use Ten cu. ft. of water per second out of Capilano Creek and to store 1700 acre feet of water out of Palisade Creek.

Moved by Cr. Murray, Seconded by Cr. Rummel: "That this be referred to His Worship the Reeve, with Cr. Gibbs and the Clerk, with power to act."

Carried unanimously.

Messrs Fleishman and Ross wrote with reference to application for approval of proposed Cemetery site in D.L. 119.

Moved by Cr. Engberg, Seconded by Cr. Gibbs: "That this be received and filed."

Carried unanimously.

His Worship the Reeve returned resolution to next meeting of the Council for reconsideration.

The members of the Board of Police Commissioners attended and addressed the Council.

Moved by Cr. Hall, Seconded by Cr. Rummel: "That the Burnaby Street Traffic Regulation By-law 1915, Amendment By-law No.2. 1925 be read a Third time."

Moved by Cr. Hall, Seconded by Cr. Smith: "That the Burnaby Street Traffic

Regulation By-law 1915, Amendment By-law No. 2. 1925 do pass the Third reading, that it be signed by the Reeve and the Clerk, and that the Corporate seal be affixed thereto."


Carried unanimously
