H. L. Mc. Clement wrote, asking for permission to construct a septic tank at Central Park tourist camp, and submitted plans.

Moved by Mr. Langford, Seconded by Mr. Gibbons: - "That this be referred to the Parks Committee and the Engineer, with power to act."

Lapsed unanimously.

The Reeve submitted a Memorandum of Agreement with the City of Vancouver re. Buswell Lake, and also re. Water Supply.

Moved by Mr. Hall, Seconded by Mr. Murray: - "That the draft agreement re. Buswell Lake, be approved."

Lapsed unanimously.

Moved by Mr. Rummel, Seconded by Mr. Gibbons: - "That the draft agreement re. Water Supply be approved."

Lapsed unanimously.

Moved by Mr. Rummel, Seconded by Mr. Murray: - "That copies of the foregoing draft agreements be forwarded to the Hon. the Prime Minister, and to the Hon. the Minister of Lands."

Lapsed unanimously.

Moved by Mr. Murray, Seconded by Mr. Rummel: - "That this council do now adjourn."
