

Monday - December 12th. 1927.

An adjourned meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall on Monday, December 12th. 1927 at 7.30 p.m.

Present: His Worship Reeve Bell in the chair.

Moved by Cr.Planche, Seconded by Cr.Moore: "That the petitions and certificates be received and filed and that the Engineer be requested to bring down report and estimate under the provisions of the Local Improvement Act."

Carried unanimously.

The Board of School Trustees submitted a request that a By-law be placed before the electors at the forthcoming Municipal Election for the sum of \$87,000.00 to provide for the extra-ordinary expenditure of the Board.

Moved by Cr. Planche, Seconded by Cr. Gray: "That a by-law be submitted as requested."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr. Planche, Seconded by Cr. Willson: "That this Council do now adjourn."
