

Wednesday - May 17th. 1928.

An adjourned meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall on Wednesday, May 17th. 1928 at 7.30 p.m.

Present: His Worship Reeve McLean.

Councillors West, Gray, Lambert, Pritchard, Planche, Shewbrooks and Wilson.

Applicants for position of Municipal Engineer were interviewed. Moved by Cr. West, Seconded by Cr. Shewbrooks: "That applications be closed." (8.45 p.m.)

Carried unanimously

On the first ballot G.L. Southwell received 3 votes, A.G. Graham 3 votes and J.E. Milne 2 votes. Second Ballot Graham 5 votes Southwell 3  
Moved by Cr. Planche, Seconded by Cr. Gray: "That A.G. Graham be appointed Municipal Engineer for this Corporation commencing June 1st at a salary of \$300.00 per month."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr. Gray, Seconded by Cr. West: "That Mr. J. Farquharson be notified

that his services as Superintendent are dispensed with forthwith."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr. West, Seconded by Cr. Shewbrooks: "That G.L. Southwell be appointed Assistant Engineer at a salary of \$200.00 per month."

Carried unanimously.

A deputation from the Civic Employees Union attended and addressed the Council re salaries of inside staff.

Moved by Cr. Planche, Seconded by Cr. Pritchard: "That the whole matter be referred to his Worship the Reeve for report and recommendation to the next meeting of the Council on Monday, May 28th. "

Carried - Cr. Lambert against.

Mr. C.C. Bell presented petition signed by 17 residents and owners abutting on the following streets: Smith Avenue from Burke to Price; Price St from Smith Avenue approximately 700 ft. west; Woodland St. 400' west of Smith; Bell Avenue from Woodland St. about 900 ft. N. and Chesham Ave. from Burke St. to Hereford St. praying that the construction of the sewers on these streets be not undertaken.

Moved by Cr. Lambert, Seconded by Cr. Gray: "That the petition be received and referred to the Solicitor for immediate advice."


Carried - Cr. West against.

Carried - Reeve McLean and Cr. West against.
