

Monday - March 19th. 1928 . .

A Regular meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall on Monday, March 19th. 1928 at 7.30 p.m.

Present: His Worship Reeve McLean in the chair.

Councillors West, Gray, Lambert, Pritchard, Planche, Shewbrooks and Wilson.

Moved by Cr.Gray, Seconded by Cr.Shewbrooks: "That the minutes of the meetings of February 22nd, 25th and 27th ultimos, and March 5th and 12th insts. be adopted as written and confirmed."

Carried unanimously.

Correspondence was received and dealt with as follows:

Corporation of B.C.Land Surveyors suggesting that greater care be taken to preserve lot stakes and concrete monuments etc. when public works are in course of construction.

Moved by Cr.Gray, Seconded by Cr.Shewbrooks: "That the letter be received and filed and a copy forwarded to the Engineer for the information of the individual foremen."

Carried unanimously.

Secretary, Ward 6 Ratepayers Association.- forwarding two resolutions (1st) That the Provincial Government be approached to have improved Lighting on Kingsway on a 75-25% basis.

(2nd) That the members of the Ward 6 Ratepayers Association deem it would have been to the best interests of Ward 6 Sewerage scheme had "Vitrified Pipe" instead of "Cement pipe" been specified.

Moved by Cr.Gray, Seconded by Cr.Pritchard: "That the letter be received and filed and that the matter of improved lighting on Kingsway be taken up with the Provincial Government."

Chief Commissioner - Greater Vancouver Water District - advising that the Board undertakes to leave road surfaces affected by the laying of pipe as laid out on Plan L.25.D. in as good condition on completion of the work as existed at time of commencement of the work.

Secretary, Burnaby Board of School Trustees requesting that danger sign be erected on the Grandview Highway at approach to Douglas Road School.

D.C.Patterson - forwarding proposals for new water supply

President, Ward 5 Ratepayers Association - asking that ex-service men be employed on Ward 5 regular and extra gangs to the extent of 50% of the whole number employed.
