Moved by Cr.Pritchard, Seconded by Cr.West: That the Burnaby Land Acquisition By-law No.5.1929 do pass the Third reading, that it be signed by the Reeve and the Clerk and that the corporate seal be affixed thereto." Carried unanimously,

A delegation of residents of vicinity re 12th Avenue at ended and addressed the Council re acquiring land to complete right of way of 12th Avenue near Douglas Read.

Moved by Cr.Rylett, Seconded by Cr.Lambert: "That the offer of E.A. Deel to sell Lot, 16, Bleck 12, D.L.29 for sum of \$525.00 be accepted." Carried unanimeusly.

Meved by Cr.Pritchard, Seconded by Cr.Wheatley: "That the Treasurer in instructed to see that the Shovel operator ispaid the standard rate of pay for operating shovel."

Carried unanimously.

A delegation from vicinity of proposed garbage dump at Gilmore Avenue south of Douglas Read attended and protested against the establishment of a dump at that point. Letters were also received as follows protesting against this dump being established.
