Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr.Lambert, Seconded by Cr.Smith: "That the Burnaby General Borrowing and Hypothecation of Taxes By-law 1950 be now read a second time."

Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr. Lambert, Seconded by Cr. Smith: "That the Burnaby Ceneral Borrowing and Hypothecation of Taxes By-law 1930 do pass the second reading."

Carried unanimously.

The Council adjourned - pro tem.

8 e clock p.m. The Council re-convened.

The Treasurer submitted recommendation that tender of Wood Gundy & Coy. for \$309,410.00 Burnaby Debentures at price of 95.7 with accrued interest be accepted. Moved by Cr.Smith, Seconded by Cr.Lambert: "That the recommendation of the Treasuper be adopted."
