

Monday - February 3rd. 1930.

An adjourned meeting of the Council was held at the Municipal Hall on Monday, February 3rd. 1930 at 7.30 o'clock p.m.  
Present: His Worship Reeve Pritchard in the chair.  
Councillors Smith, Shaw, Lambert, Edwards, Wheatley, Shewbrooks and Wilson.

Tenders for Debentures were received as follows:

Wood, Gundy & Coy. \$95.70 and accrued interest.  
McLeod, Young, Weir & Coy. Ltd  
and Victor W Odum, Brown & Co. \$294,394.33

Moved by Cr. Lambert, Seconded by Cr. Smith: "That these tenders be referred to the Treasurer for tabulation and recommendation."  
Carried unanimously.

The Building Inspector submitted a recommendation that action be taken under Section 162 of the Municipal Act to have George Gray owner of Lot 8, SD 34-38, Blocks 1 and 3, D.L.95, remove certain buildings certified by the Building Inspector as being a nuisance and danger to the public.  
Moved by Cr. Shewbrooks, Seconded by Cr. Edwards: "That the recommendation of the Building Inspector be adopted."  
Carried unanimously.

The Building Inspector submitted a recommendation that C. Smith of Fraser Arm, P.O. be granted a "Public Hall License" subject to his undertaking to do certain work within three months. Mr. Smith submitted his undertaking to this effect.  
Moved by Cr. Shewbrooks, Seconded by Cr. Lambert: "That a License for a Public Hall on the premises referred to be granted."  
Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr. Lambert, Seconded by Cr. Smith: "That the Burnaby General Borrowing and Hypothecation of Taxes By-law 1930 be introduced and read a first time."  
Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr. Lambert, Seconded by Cr. Smith: "That the Burnaby General Borrowing and Hypothecation of Taxes By-law 1930 do pass the first reading."  
Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr. Lambert, Seconded by Cr. Smith: "That the Burnaby General Borrowing and Hypothecation of Taxes By-law 1930 be now read a second time."  
Carried unanimously.

Moved by Cr. Lambert, Seconded by Cr. Smith: "That the Burnaby General Borrowing and Hypothecation of Taxes By-law 1930 do pass the second reading."  
Carried unanimously.

The Council adjourned - pro tem.

8 o'clock p.m. The Council re-convened.

The Treasurer submitted recommendation that tender of Wood Gundy & Coy. for \$309,410.00 Burnaby Debentures at price of 95.7 with accrued interest be accepted.  
Moved by Cr. Smith, Seconded by Cr. Lambert: "That the recommendation of the Treasurer be adopted."  
Carried unanimously.

The Council then adjourned.
