Moved by Cr.Lench, Seconded by Cr.Wilson: "That the amount per ward do not exceed \$300,000.00"

Carried - Crs.Pylett and Lambert against.

Moved by Cr.Pylett, Seconded by Cr.Wilson: "That the items suggested by the Chairman of the Board of School Trustees be provided for in the suggested programme."

Carried unanimously.
