

Wednesday - September 13th, 1933.

A regular sitting of the Commissioner was held at the Municipal Hall on Wednesday, September 13th, 1933 at 10.00 a.m.  
Present: Commissioner John Bennett and the Municipal Clerk.

Ordered: "That the minutes of the sitting of September 6th inst. be adopted as written and confirmed."

Correspondence was received and dealt with as follows:

1. Secretary, Town Planning Commission - advising that the Commission tentatively zoned Lots 9, 17 and 18, Block 16, and Lots 1, 2, 17 and 18 of Block 13, D.L. 158 as a Local Commercial area, and that in view of this tentative zoning recommended that the provisions of the existing town planning by-law be waived to permit of the erection and operation of a store building on Lot 1, Block 16, D.L. 168 by Mr. G.P. Hovey.  
Ordered: "That the letter be received and filed and that the recommendation be adopted."

2. Messrs Milledge and McQuarrie - advising that as Mr. W.G. McQuarrie had retired from practice following his elevation to the Appeal court Bench it was their intention to continue the practice together and requesting that they be allowed to retain the Municipal solicitorship.  
Ordered: "That the letter be received and filed."

3. The Acting Deputy Municipal Engineer submitted a report advising that Still Creek Bridge on Douglas Road has been closed to traffic owing to the unsafe condition of same and recommending that two 10" valves be installed in the 10" water main at either end of the bridge to enable water service to be maintained in the event of a break - Estimated cost \$192.00  
Ordered: "That the report of the Engineer be approved and that the recommendation be adopted."
