

Wednesday May 17th.1933.

A Regular sitting of the Commissioner was held at the Municipal Hall on Wednesday, May 17th.1933 at 10.00 a.m.  
Present: Commissioner Bennett and Municipal Clerk.

Ordered: "That the minutes of the sitting of May 10th inst. be adopted as written and confirmed."

Correspondence was received and dealt with as follows:

1. J. S. Pyner - requesting permission to use Lot 4, Block 21, D.L. 121 for garden purposes:

Ordered: "That permission be granted to the end of this year at a nominal rental of \$1.00."

2. J.M.Holmes and others - requesting permission to clear Lots 1 to 4 and 8 to 12, Block 23, D.L. 99 as a childrens playground free of all cost to the Corporation.

Ordered: "That permission be granted subject to the work being done under the supervision of and to the satisfaction of the Municipal Engineer."

3. The Building Inspector submitted Progress certificate in favour of Mott Electric Coy. in sum of \$297.02 in full payment for contract for removal of old Police telephone system.

Ordered: "That the certificate be approved for payment."

The Relief Officer submitted report for period May 1st to 15th. showing total number of relief cases as 2191 with total cost of \$18,648.18

Ordered: "That the report be received and filed."

4. The Treasurer submitted recommendation that the sum of \$40.60, being interest on sale of Block 18, D.L.124. be foregone in consideration of the purchasers paying the balance due on principal plus taxes.

Ordered: "That the recommendation of the Treasurer be approved."

5. The Deputy Municipal Engineer submitted recommendation that no objection be entered against the proposal of the B.C.E.R. Co. to move the present station at Glen Lyon on the Marpole line to Sussex Avenue, and suggested that should such change be made that the station be renamed.

Ordered: "That the recommendations of the Engineer be adopted."

6. The Deputy Municipal Engineer submitted report on the condition of Douglas Road paving, advising that in his opinion the reason for this pavement deteriorating was due to the fact that the work was carried out too late in the season.

Ordered: "That the report be received and tabled for further consideration."

The Deputy Municipal Engineer submitted estimates of work as follows:

Ordered: "That the Estimates of work be adopted subject to funds being available."

Ordered: "That the Thomas Kirk Property Sale By-law 1933 do pass the Third reading, that it be signed by the Commissioner and the Clerk and that the Corporate seal be affixed thereto."

Ordered: "That the Commissioner do now sit as a committee of the whole to reconsider Burnaby Property Exchange By-law No.2.1933."

Ordered: "That the Committee do now rise and report the by-law complete without amendment."

Ordered: "That the Burnaby Property Exchange By-law No.2.1933 be now read a Third time."

Ordered: "That the Burnaby Property Exchange By-law No.2.1933 do pass the Third reading, that it be signed by the Commissioner and the Clerk and that the Corporate seal be affixed thereto."

Ordered: "That the Requisitions as submitted be approved."
