

Wednesday December 20th, 1933.

A Regular sitting of the Commissioner was held at the Municipal Hall on Wednesday, December 20th, 1933 at 10.45 a.m.
Present: Commissioner Mahony and the Municipal Clerk.

Ordered: "That the minutes of the sitting of December 13th inst. be adopted as written and confirmed."

Correspondence was received and dealt with as follows:

Broadview C. C. F. Club requesting that increased fire protection facilities be provided for the Broadview district.

1. The Chief Constable submitted report advising that the district in question was served by only 8 hydrants and that additional protection in the way of hose would be of little avail without more hydrants. The Chief Constable estimated cost of supplying quantity of 1 1/2" fire hose and hand drawn hose reel at \$150.00

Ordered: "That the letter be received and filed and the writer be advised as per the report of the Chief Constable."

2. R. Bolton, Treasurer - advising that George Connor a purchaser under the Better Housing Act has completed payments under the agreement and that it was now in order to issue him a deed of the land viz: Lot 17, Blocks 42/43, D.L. 152/3.

Ordered: "That the letter be received and filed."

Ordered: "That the Commissioner and the Clerk be and are hereby authorized to execute under the provisions of the "Better Housing Act" a conveyance of Lot 17, Blocks 42/43, D.L. 152/153, Group 1, N.W.D. Map 1566, from the Corporation of the District of Burnaby to George Connor, and to affix the Corporate seal thereto."

Ordered: "That the Commissioner do now sit as a Committee of the Whole to reconsider "Burnaby Taxes Abatement By-law 1933"

Ordered: "That the Committee do now rise and report the By-law complete without amendment."

Ordered: "That the Burnaby Taxes Abatement By-law 1933 be now read a Third time."

Ordered: "That the Burnaby Taxes Abatement By-law 1933 do pass the third reading, that it be signed by the Commissioner and the Clerk and that the Corporate seal be affixed thereto."

The sitting then adjourned.
