

Wednesday, November 22nd, 1933.

The Regular sitting of the Commissioner was held at the Municipal Hall, Edmonds on Wednesday, November 22nd, at 10.30 A.M.

Present: Commissioner John Mahony and the Municipal Clerk.

Ordered: "That the minutes of the sitting of November 15th. be adopted as written and confirmed."

Correspondence was received and dealt with as follows:-

City Clerk - Moose Jaw enclosing copy of resolution passed pertaining to Relief, and requesting endorsement thereof.

Ordered: "That this communication be received and filed."

Crehan, Wouat and Co. wrote enclosing Progress Report with regard to the audit of the books for 1933.

Ordered: "That this report be received and filed."

John Waplington - requesting permission to remove peat from Lots 4 & 5, Blk. 17, T.L. '79.

The Deputy Municipal Engineer submitted report recommending that permission be granted subject to the following terms:-

Payment of five cents per bale of 70 lbs. for all peat removed.

That the peat be removed in reasonably large quantities and packed for measurement before being removed, and the Corporation notified when each newly stacked quantity of baled peat is ready for measurement.

The applicant to supply all necessary material and labour free of cost to the Corporation for the construction of roadways into or out of said described lands and shall keep all road drains open and in good order.

The Corporation agrees not to grant permission to any other party to cut and take peat from aforesaid lands during the continuance of this agreement.

This agreement to be terminated by either party by a months notice given in writing.

Ordered: "That the report of the engineer be adopted."

Property Salesman submitted report on application of W. Loat to purchase Lots 5, 6, 7B, Block 8, District Lot 40, for the sum of \$105. , advising that the property was outside the water area and also that the applicant desired road construction estimated to cost \$95.00.

Ordered "that the report be tabled for further consideration."

Engineer submitted report on Gault Sewer in lane north of Oxford Street between Esmond Avenue and Ingleton Avenue, a length of about 410 feet, and submitted estimate of cost of proposed work as follows:-

General Accounts \$17,538.76, Relief Accounts \$1,847.36, Pay Rolls \$2,554.19 Salaries \$5,465.30, Land Sale Commissions \$2.00, were examined.

Ordered: "That these accounts be approved for payment as and when funds are available."

The sitting then adjourned.
