

Wednesday - June 28th. 1933.

A Regular sitting of the Commissioner was held at the Municipal Hall on Wednesday, June 28th. 1933 at 10.00 a.m.
Present: Commissioner Bennett and the Municipal Clerk.

Ordered: "That the minutes of the sitting of June 21st inst. be adopted as written and confirmed."

Correspondence was received and dealt with as follows:

W.S. Puell - expressing appreciation of the action of the Commissioner in taking steps to prevent the establishment of a T.B. Sanatorium at "Fairacres" on Gilpin Street.
Ordered: "That the letter be received and filed."

The Deputy Municipal Engineer submitted Estimates of work for approval as follows:

Board of Works	\$580.00
Waterworks - Repairs.	200.00
Waterworks - Inspectors.	111.93

Ordered: "That these Estimates be approved subject to funds being available."

The Deputy Municipal Engineer submitted recommendation that B.C. Telephone Co pole plan A. 11446 covering proposed pole location and lateral along Gilley Avenue, between McKee and Neville Streets be approved, poles to be set 10' 6" from outside face of pole to property line.

Ordered: "That the recommendation of the Deputy Engineer be and is hereby adopted."

The Requisitions were then examined.

Ordered: "That the Requisitions as submitted be approved."

The sitting then adjourned.
