

Wednesday - November 29th, 1933.

A Regular sitting of the Commissioner was held at the Municipal Hall on Wednesday November 29th, 1933 at 10.30 a.m.
Present: Commissioner John Mahony and the Municipal Clerk.

Ordered: "That the minutes of the sitting of November 22nd inst. be adopted as written and confirmed."

Correspondence was received and dealt with as follows:

1. W.P. Philips - Assessor - recommending that frontage charges under West Burnaby Sewer By-law and Local Improvement Construction By-law No.14, respecting Lot 26, Block 36, D.L.151~~3~~ be reduced from 48 feet to 15 feet.
Ordered: "That the recommendation of the Assessor be and is hereby adopted."

W.Loat - resubmitting his offer to purchase Lots 5, 6, and 7B of Block 8, D.L.40 conditional upon this Corporation opening up the roadway of Piper Avenue fronting Lot 6.
Ordered: "That the letter be received and filed and Mr.Loat be advised that this offer cannot be entertained."
