

wednesday - June 13th. 1934.

A Regular sitting of the Commissioner was held at the Municipal Hall on Wednesday, June 13th. 1934 at 10.00 a.m.
Present: Commissioner Fraser; Mr. F. Bolton and the Municipal Clerk.

Ordered: "That the minutes of the sitting of June 6th inst. be adopted as written and confirmed."

Correspondence was received and dealt with as follows:

1 C. Gray - requesting access to Lots 3, 4, 5, 17 and 18, Block 12, D.L. 76. The Works Superintendent submitted estimate of cost amounting to \$805.00 Mr. Gray attended and addressed the Commissioner pointing out that he merely desired reasonable access to Lots 17 and 18 only, and that in his opinion this access could be provided by an expenditure of approximately \$50.00
Ordered: "That the letter be received and filed and that Mr. Gray and the Works Superintendent meet on the ground to discuss the matter further."

2 The Building Inspector submitted report on the complaint of residents re drainage nuisance at Coconut Grove - Grandview Highway - advising that the operators had arranged to make certain alterations which would remedy the situation.

Ordered: "That the report be received and filed and the complainants be notified as per the report and further that the Building Inspector be requested to keep a close watch on the situation."

3 The Treasurer submitted further report on his recommendation that tax sale certificate covering Lot 14E, SD 15, Blocks 11 - 13 to 16, D.L. 158E, be sold to Catherine Stapleton - advising that the original owner had been written to but that the letter had not been delivered.
Ordered: "That the report be received and filed."

Ordered: "That the recommendation of the Treasurer dated June 6th inst. that tax sale certificate covering Lot 14E, S.D. 15, Blocks 11, 13 to 16, D.L. 158 East had. be sold to Catherine Stapleton for sum of \$60.30 be and is hereby adopted."

 Ordered: "That the recommendation of the Property salesman and the Assessor be and is hereby adopted."

The Relief Officer submitted report for month of May showing total number of Relief cases as 2197 with total cost of \$40,241.21
 Ordered: "That the report be received and filed."

The Treasurer submitted report showing overhead cost of the Relief department for the month of May as \$2,477.75
 Ordered: "That the report be received and filed."

The Requisitions were then examined.
 Ordered: "That the Requisitions as submitted be approved."

2 Ordered: "That lease of Lot 8, Blocks 38 to 40, D.L.98 to Wm.J.R.Greenslade be signed by the Commissioner and the Clerk and that the corporate seal be affixed thereto."

3 Ordered: "That lease of Blocks 32 to 35, D.L.96 to Leonard K.Hawkins and Eleanor Mary Hawkins be signed by the Commissioner and the Clerk and that the Corporate seal be affixed thereto."

4 Ordered: "That agreement Dominion Specialty Company Limited and Burnaby re licenses for Automatic Vending Machines be signed by the Commissioner and the Clerk and that the Corporate seal be affixed thereto."

The sitting then adjourned at 10.35 a.m.
