

Wednesday - November 14th, 1934.

A Regular sitting of the Commissioner was held at the Municipal Hall on Wednesday, November 14th, 1934 at 10.00 a.m.
Present: Commissioner Fraser; Mr. R. Bolton; Mr. E. P. Scott; Mr. A. McFes; Mr. E. L. Rimmer, Mr. A. C. Bell and the Municipal Clerk.

Ordered: "That the minutes of the sitting of November 7th inst. be adopted as written and confirmed."

Correspondence was received and dealt with as follows:

E. W. Bateman - requesting gravelling on Deer Lake Avenue.

Ordered: "That this letter be received and be referred to the Works Superintendent."

1. V. H. Dallamore - 4th Burnaby Rover Scouts - requesting refund of rental paid for use of Fir Lodge - Central Park - on October 27th, 1934.

Ordered: "That the letter be received and a refund of the amount paid be made."

2. A. C. Earsby - calling attention to condition of sidewalk crossing at N.E. Corner of Triumph Street and MacDonald Avenue, and requesting that consideration be given to installing a street light at this point.

Ordered: "That this request be referred to the Building Inspector for report and recommendation."

3. A. C. Bell - Local Assistant Fire Marshal - forwarding copy of order made by him on Mr. F. J. Wells, re North half of Lot 7, SD 35/36, D.L. 158.

Ordered: "That the letter be received and that the Property Salesman and Assessor be requested to report as to the condition of the building situate on these premises."
