

Wednesday - August 15th, 1934.

A Regular sitting of the Commissioner was held at the Municipal Hall on Wednesday, August 15th, 1934 at 10.00 a.m.
 Present: Commissioner Fraser, W.P. Philips, Assessor; A. McFee, Property Salesman and the Clerk, and F.J. Sundle.
 Ordered: That the minutes of the sitting of August 8th inst. be adopted as written and confirmed."

Correspondence was received and dealt with as follows:

Chief Probation Officer - forwarding copy of order of Juvenile Court committing Patrick and Kathleen O'Brian to the Roman Catholic Children's Aid Society with order for maintenance in each case against the Corporation of Burnaby.
 Ordered: "That the letter and order be received and filed."

J. E. Lubbock - applying to lease Lots 18 to 30, Block "A" and Lot "A" of Block 5, D.L. 87, for grazing purposes for a term of 5 years at an annual rental of \$50.00 per annum.
 The Assessor and Property Salesman submitted recommendation that Lots 20 to 30, of Block "A" and Lot "A" of Block 5, D.L. 87 be leased to Mr. Lubbock for 5 years at a rental of \$50.00 per annum.
 Ordered: "That the recommendation of the Property Salesman and Assessor be and is hereby adopted."

Secretary, Provisional Board - Lower Mainland - Natural Products Marketing Act forwarding report of meeting held on August 8th inst. and requesting that potato and vegetable growers in this municipality sign petition requesting the Minister of Agriculture to have the above act applied to the Lower Mainland of British Columbia.
 Ordered: "That the letter and report be received and the matter be referred to the local Farmers Institutes for their information and such action as is considered necessary."

C. E. Herrett - forwarding petition under the Shops Regulation Act praying for the passing of a By-law to close Barber shops in Burnaby at 7.00 p.m. on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday, at 8 p.m. on Saturday, at 1 p.m. on Wednesday, and at 8 p.m. on all days preceding all statutory holidays and to be closed all day on statutory holidays.
 The Clerk submitted certified that the petition was signed by seventy five percent of the license holders for Barbers licenses in the municipality.
 Ordered: "That the petition and certificate be received and filed."

The Building Inspector submitted recommendation that the provisions of the Burnaby Town Planning By-law be waived to permit of the erection of a residence on Lot 1, Blocks 55/58, D.L. 32 at a distance of not less than 16 feet from the front property line on account of the other houses in this block having been built at that distance from the property line.
 Ordered: "That the recommendation of the Building Inspector be and is hereby adopted."

The Property Salesman and Assessor submitted further report on application of Mrs. P. Sellers to have rent of 3409 Barker Avenue reduced and recommended that the monthly rent be reduced from \$20.00 to \$18.00
 Ordered: "That the recommendation of the Property Salesman and the Assessor be and is hereby adopted."
