

Wednesday - May 16th, 1934.

A Regular sitting of the Commissioner was held at the Municipal Hall on Wednesday, May 16th, 1934 at 10.00 a.m.
Present: Commissioner Fraser, Mr. R. Bolton and the Municipal Clerk.

Ordered: "That the minutes of the sitting of May 10th inst. be adopted as written and confirmed."

Correspondence was received and dealt with as follows:

Mrs. M. A. Rothwell, Secretary, V.O.N. Board requesting permission to hold annual house to house canvas for funds for the V.O.N.

Ordered: "That the letter be received and filed and the Board be granted permission to hold a house to house canvas for funds in aid of the V.O.N. Work in this Municipality."

Pemberton & Son - offering to sell \$1000.00 District of Burnaby 8% Debentures due May 1st, 1944 at 65 flat.

Hall, Holland & Coy. - offering to sell \$2000.00 District of Burnaby 5 1/2% Debentures, due Dec. 31st, 1942 at \$62.50 flat with all unpaid coupons attached.

The Treasurer recommended that the above offers be accepted.

Ordered: "That the recommendation of the Treasurer be and is hereby adopted."

Treasurer, Burnaby Branch, V.O.N. - conveying on behalf of the Board of Management of the V.O.N. their thanks for the Grant made by the Corporation towards the work of the Order.

Ordered: "That the letter be received and filed."

Ordered: "That the report be received and filed and that the Treasurer be requested to submit monthly report showing overhead costs of the Relief department."

Ordered: "That Hugh M. Fraser, Commissioner; Richard Bolton, Treasurer and Charles B. Brown, Clerk, or any two of them be and they are hereby authorised to sign agreement respecting safety deposit box at the Royal Bank of Canada and to have access to and control of the contents of such safe deposit box."

Ordered: "That the "Cabaret Regulation By-law 1934" do pass the first reading."

Ordered: "That the "Cabaret Regulation By-law 1934" be now read a second time."

Ordered: "That the "Cabaret Regulation By-law 1934" do pass the second reading."

The sitting then adjourned at 10.30 a.m.
