

Saturday - March 17th. 1934.

A Sitting of the Commissioner was held on Saturday, March 17th. 1934 at 11.15 a.m. at the Municipal Hall.

Present: Commissioner Fraser - R. Bolton and C.E. Brown.

Ordered: "That the order of March 14th inst. re sale of debentures to The Western City Company Limited be and is hereby rescinded."

The Western City Company Limited wrote offering to purchase £400. Grand Trunk Pacific, Saskatchewan guaranteed, 4% Bonds due 1939 at a price of 91.75 and accrued interest for £300. and 92.00 and accrued interest for £100. and also offered to sell to the Corporation \$2000. Dist. of Burnaby (By-law 562) at 61.50 flat.

Ordered: "That the sale of £300. Grand Trunk Pacific (Province of Saskatchewan guaranteed) 4% bonds, due 1939 at 91.75 and accrued interest, and £100. Grand Trunk Pacific (Province of Saskatchewan guaranteed) 4% bonds due 1939 at 92.00 and accrued interest to the Western City Company Limited be approved, and that the Commissioner and the Clerk be and are hereby authorized to sign the Indenture of Transfer and to affix the Corporate seal thereto."

The sitting then adjourned.
