The-6 A regular sitting of the Commissioner was held at the Municipal Hall on Wednesday, August 22nd, 1934 at 10.00 a.m.
Present: Commissioner Fraser - Mr. R. Bolton. and the Clerk.
Ordered: "That the minutes of the sitting of August 15th inst. be adopted as written and confirmed."

Correspondence was received and dealt with as follows:

Archivist - Canadian Legion - requesting that the German Machine guns now lying in the basement at the Municipal Hall be handed over to the Legion for their collection.
Ordered: "That this matter be referred to the Clerk with power to act."

Geo. C. Darts and other practicing Dentists in the Municipality - protesting against method of carrying out Relief dental work.
Ordered: "That the letter be received and filed and a meeting be arranged."
