

Wednesday, July 25th, 1934.

A Regular sitting of the Commissioner was held at the Municipal Hall, Edmonds, Wednesday, July 25th, 1934 at 10 o'clock A.M.
Present: Commissioner H. M. Fraser and R. Bolton, Treasurer.

Ordered: "That the minutes of the sitting of July 18th. be adopted as written and confirmed."

W. G. Thomson wrote requesting removal of growth on Delta Avenue.
Ordered: "That this matter be referred to the Engineer for action."

M. E. Cawker wrote requesting that brush be cleared off the sidewalk on Warwick Avenue.
Ordered: "That this matter be referred to the Engineer for action."

Medical Health Officer submitted report on Dr. Ballard's Abattoir and Drainage Scheme, advising that alterations were now being made to take care of the effluent from the Abattoir. The Medical Health Officer also recommended that when the said work was completed to his satisfaction, the plans as drawn up by Dr. Ballard for draining the land be considered.
Ordered: "That this report be received, and that no permit be issued until the Medical Health Officer had passed on Sanitary conditions."

The Works Superintendent submitted Estimates of Work as follows:
