

Wednesday - February 28th. 1934.

A Regular sitting of the Commissioner was held at the Municipal Hall on Wednesday, February 28th, 1934 at 10.00 a.m.

Present: Commissioner Fraser; Mr. R. Bolton and the Municipal Clerk.

Ordered: "That the minutes of the sitting of February 21st inst. be adopted as written and confirmed."

Correspondence was received and dealt with as follows:

Wood-Gundy & Co Ltd., offering to sell \$2,000.00 District of Burnaby 5 1/2% Bonds, Due 31 December 1942 at 64 flat, and to purchase from the Corporation Two hundred and eighty one pounds sterling Province of British Columbia Guaranteed 4 1/2% Stock issued by Pacific Great Eastern Railway - due 15th July 1942 at 94.50 and interest, less 3 cents per \$100.00 transfer tax.

Ordered: "That the sale of Two hundred and eighty one pounds Sterling Pacific Great Eastern Railway (B.C. Guaranteed) 4 1/2% Stock to Wood Gundy and Company Limited at 94.50 and interest, less 3 cts per \$100 transfer tax in accordance with the terms of their letter of February 23rd inst. be and is hereby approved, and that the Commissioner and the Clerk be and are hereby authorised to sign the indenture of transfer and to affix the corporate seal thereto."
